NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

- Competitors through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of USDAA rules and regulations as amended July 1, 2009, including but not limited to the following rules regarding entry: USDAA's official rules & regulations are hereby incorporated by reference.
- This test is open to all dogs being at least 18 months of age including purebred and non-purebred, except bitches in season, dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance, or dogs exhibiting signs of aggression.
- All dogs must be registered with USDAA in order to compete. You may obtain a registration number immediately and a measurement card prior to the show online at www.usdaa.com, click on General Information, Dog Registration. If your dog is not already registered, fill out the form on the back of the entry and submit registration fee of \$20. FRAC will forward the registration information to USDAA and a registration number will be issued and sent back to the show secretary so that every dog in the event will have a valid USDAA registration number.
- Entries close Monday, August 9th at 5 pm.** No entries will be accepted after this time.
- Changes to entries will be accepted in writing via e-mail, or regular mail until 5 pm Monday, August 16th, for purposes of advancing entry to the next higher class level for those dogs finishing titles through shows of the weekend of August 14 & 15. The email address and street address are listed elsewhere in this premium. Changes will be accepted only for dogs entered by the closing date of August 9th. **Express entries must have signatures waived.**

- No leads, collars, food, toys or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course at any time.
- Safety shall always be of foremost consideration in actions and conduct by handlers at all times.
- The Organizing Committee of an event may refuse the entry of any competitor or dog for just cause should the committee view that participation by competitor or dog would be prejudicial to the sport. However, any committee so doing must notify the competitor in writing (with a copy to the USDAA office) in anticipation of or upon receipt of entry. The notice must include the reason for refusing the entry and a brief explanation of the basis for their decision. The burden of responsibility for appropriateness of such action rests solely with the host group and its Organizing Committee.
- THERE WILL BE NO REFUNDS** for entries withdrawn after the closing date or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for dismissal. There will also be no substitution or replacement dogs allowed for dogs that have been entered. A 50% refund may be available for the following reasons: bitches coming in to season or injury/illness after the closing date. Each incident will be approved on a case-by-case basis and a letter from your vet will be required. **In such instances, the secretary MUST be notified by phone or e-mail no later than the Monday prior to the trials.** Any withdrawals after that Monday are not eligible for a refund.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. There will be a \$20.00 service charge for returned checks. Payment of entry fees and service charges shall be made in cash or money order within 30 days of postmark of notice of returned check notification if received after event date. Any fees not received within 30 days of notice result in cancellation of event results for all classes for the registration number(s) of delinquent entry/entries. No reinstatement of results is possible, and all awards must be returned within 10 days of notification, or the dog's registration may be suspended pending restitution. Any unpaid fees or shortfalls must be paid prior to the start of the event or entry is cancelled without recourse by owner/handler.
- In the event of a larger entry, fault limits may be set at the discretion of the Organizing Committee/Judge and announced in judge's briefings.
- There will be no equipment familiarization. This event will be held indoors on packed dirt.
- Running order will be determined by random draw and published in the event catalog. Handlers with more than one dog will be separated whenever possible. All dogs must be ringside and ready to run in catalog order. The ring WILL NOT wait for any dog.
- Please help us keep this site by keeping crating and exercise areas clean and picking up after yourselves and your dogs. Dogs must be on leash at all times when not in the ring or the warm up area.
- All Competitors through entry at this event waive any and all rights relative to video broadcast of this event. Competitors shall have the right to videotape portions of this event for their personal use only. No portion of this event may be videotaped for commercial or other purposes. All video, broadcast and telecast rights for this event are the exclusive property of United States Dog Agility Association, Inc. Portions of this event may be taped for television. Through entry at this event, ALL COMPETITORS and HANDLERS HEREBY GRANT to USDAA and its representatives, agents and assigns, all rights and permission to use or appropriate his/her and their dog's name, biography, likeness, photograph, voice, performing persona, or other indicia of identity for broadcast, telecast, cablecast, transmission or distribution in any format or media now known. All competitors and handlers hereby release USDAA and its representatives, agents and assigns from any claim or cause of action for invasion of the rights of privacy, right of publicity, right of personality, or any similar right.
- A discount of 50% is available to handlers under 18 years old. Remember to take this discount when you fill out the entry form.

MEASURING & CHECK-IN

COMPETITORS MUST CHECK-IN for measuring at the site on their first day of competition. Friday Check in is 1:00pm-1:30pm. Checkin on Saturday and Sunday is from 7-7:30am each day. Dogs not presented for check in at these times WILL NOT RUN! Judging will begin at 2:00pm on Friday and 8:00 am Saturday and Sunday

All dogs must be measured prior to being checked in UNLESS the dog jumps 26" (22" in Perf), the handler presents a permanent card, a temporary card with 3 signatures awaiting a CMJ or check-in letter issued by USDAA / print out of dog info page from subscriber account indicating the dog is permanently carded. Dogs that are measured up must run first in the higher height. In the event the dog is unprepared for the higher height, they may be run For Exhibition Only, but no awards or qualifying scores may be earned and no change in program is allowed.

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS & ELIGIBILITY

The following titling classes are being offered at the Starters, Advanced, Masters and Performance 1, 2, and 3 levels at this event: Gamblers, Jumpers, Pairs Relay, Snooker and Standard. A complete description of these classes and the requirements for eligibility for entry may be found in Chapters 3 - 7 of the Official USDAA Rules & Regulations, which are incorporated in this test schedule by reference. A summary of eligibility requirements for all titling classes is presented in Appendix E of the Rules & Regulations.

Note that effective 1/1/09, Pairs will be required for versatility titles in Performance. Should only one dog be entered in a program / level, a partner from another program/level may not be solicited to make a qualifying pair.

The following 2010 tournament qualifiers are being offered at this event. Descriptions have been edited to save space. All competitors are eligible for entry to these classes; a copy of the tournament regulations for each tournament may be found on the USDAA Web site at www.usdaa.com or by contacting USDAA at the address below

Grand Prix of Dog Agility® World Championships & Performance Grand PrixSM Championships Local Qualifiers: These single-round tournaments are open to all dogs regardless of skill level or titles earned and are judged under Masters rules. Competitors earning ZERO faults shall earn a qualifying score. The first place dog/handler in each jump height earning a qualifying score will be awarded a 'bye' in the final round of a Regional Championship. One qualifying score is required to enter Round 1 of a Regional Championship and two (2) qualifying scores are required to enter the quarterfinals at the world championships.

Dog Agility Steeplechase® & Performance Speed JumpingSM: These two-round tournaments are open to all dogs regardless of skill level or titles earned and are judged under modified Starters rules. A qualifying score is earned in Round 1. In Steeplechase one qualifying score is required to enter Round 1 of a Regional qualifier and two scores are required to enter the quarterfinals at the world championships. A 'bye' may be earned in Round 2 of a regional championships. In Speed Jumping two (2) qualifying scores are required for entry at the world championships.

PRIZES AND AWARDS

All Agility Test Classes. Separate first through third place rosettes will be awarded in each class for each jump height classification respectively. Pairs will be awarded to mini and open divisions. Maroon qualifying ribbons will be awarded to those dogs earning qualifying scores.

All Tournament Classes: First through third placement rosettes will be awarded in each tournament class for each jump height. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all Grand Prix and Performance GP qualifiers.

Prize money shall be computed based upon 30% of the total entry fees to be allocated in accordance with the payout table below regardless of the size of entry in any height class.
